## NOTE ON BOOKS

Completing the reading assignments in advance of the class is essential to receiving the full benefit of the in-class conversation. Because tuition is funded largely by the Mercer Scholarship Fund, we do not obtain books for auditors, and charge only a minimal administrative fee of \$25 per course. Most of the books are priced new under \$30, and many are available used or new through third party sellers at significant discounts. Kindle versions of all the books are available, usually at a significantly lower price. There are different editions of the MacCulloch book, and the pages cited above are for the original 2003 edition. While the book is recommended, you don't need to purchase it. Scanned copies of the pages assigned from that book will be emailed prior to the relevant class session.
